Coaches are appointed by the President and approved by the Board of Directors.

The youth softball coach must be a leader. All coaches must recognize that they hold a position of trust. It is a responsibility in a program that deals with a sensitive and formative period of a youngster's development. It is required that a coach have understanding, patience and the capacity to work with all youngsters. The coach must be aware that the attainment of exceptional athletic skill or the winning of games and championships is secondary, and that the teaching of good sportsmanship, teamwork, honesty, loyalty and respect for authority is of prime importance.

For the position of Coach at the 14U Division, a person should have at least three years official coaching experience within FCYSA, or the equivalent. For the position of Coach at the 12U and 10U levels, a person should have at least two years of official coaching experience within FCYSA, or the equivalent. Assistant coaches at the 14U, 12U and 10U levels should generally have at least one year of official coaching experience or equivalent.

The Coach shall be responsible for the conduct of his or her players, team parents, and team volunteers at all league games and practices. The Coach must demonstrate that he/she has an appreciation for the philosophy of FCYSA, and cooperate with the Board of Directors and others in making the program of mutual benefit to all youngsters.

All Coaches MUST show by example that they respect the judgment and position of authority of the umpire, and at the same time instill in their players a respect for authority of adult leaders in the league. The Coach must exercise a leadership role, but at the same time leave the game in the hands of the players. The Coach must, within FCYSA rules, provide an opportunity for every player to take part in every game.

The Coach must also encourage players at every opportunity. The Coach must know the playing rules of softball and be able to interpret them correctly. The Coach must make every possible effort to correct any violation of the rules before they occur to prevent any protest situation. It is also recommended that all coaches have a basic knowledge of first aid and safety.

The Board of Directors, by the power vested therein and within the League Bylaws, retains the power to remove any Coach or Assistant Coach from his or her position if his or her actions are viewed as detrimental to the team and/or to the well being of the league. The Coach/Assistant Coach does have the right to a hearing before the Board of Directors in such a case, as outlined in the Bylaws.
